



Announcing the P&SI Compendium

A research tool indexing a
decade of IWIPS proceedings

Over the past decade, IWIPS meetings on three continents have published thousands of pages of original internationalization research, in their annual proceedings.

Until now, accessing this treasure trove of I18N and L10N material has been a matter of manually skimming paper titles in many tables of contents – with the inherent limitations of titles as descriptors.

That will soon be a thing of the past. Currently in production is the P&SI Compendium, a collection of indices providing insight into all that IWIPS has generated, since 1999.

Using the Compendium's author, title and keyword indices, it will be possible to trace the work of individual authors from year-to-year; to see the weave of concepts from author-to-author, and to access complete citation details.

Completion of the Compendium is expected sometime this northern fall, in concert with P&SI plans to make the proceedings themselves more readily available.
